

RESOLUTION NO. 653

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE CITY OF CLINTON'S 2009 HOME REHABILITATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS the City of Clinton successfully made application to the Tennessee Housing Development Agency (THDA) and received HOME funds in the amount of \$218,296; and

WHEREAS the City will expend the funds for the purpose of rehabilitating substandard housing within its corporate limits on a City wide basis for low and very low income families; and

WHEREAS it is the intent of the City to assure its residents that all applications for the grant assistance will be prioritized in a manner that will identify the low and very low income households which are in the greatest need of the program's assistance and therefore develop a priority list representative of this need; and

WHEREAS it is the intent of the City to ensure that all policies regarding the rehabilitation of homes are equitable and comply with the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Tennessee Housing Development Agency's program requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, with concurrence from the Tennessee Housing Development Agency, that the City of Clinton's City Council does hereby adopt the Program Policies and Procedures for Clinton's 2009 HOME Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Clinton's City Council does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute the required HOME Program documents and to review, monitor and coordinate the program implementation activities performed by City's staff and its consultant.
