REGULAR CITY COUNCIL - MINUTES

Councilman Rob Herrell made a motion to approve the agenda and seconded by Councilman Zach Farrar. Motion carried.

Prayer was led by Councilman Jim McBride followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Brian Hatmaker made a motion to approve December 14, 2018 minutes and seconded by Councilman Larry Gann. Motion carried.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS AND CITIZENS

Mayor Burton asked for comments from the citizens.

Jennifer Burnette, ASAP, discussed programs offered by ASAP.

John Sutton, Pugh & Company, PC presented the 2018 Audit Report, reported that there were no findings. He congratulated Finance Director, Gail Cook for receiving the CAFR award again this year.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR

Mayor Burton commented on a meeting he attended with Joe Hollingsworth Group for property in South Clinton that Mr. Hollingsworth would like to develop into a public park. One concern of City staff is a small portion of land that contains fly ash. Mayor Burton asked city council if they would agree to authorize City Manager Houck to contract with TDEC to inspect the property and provide an official opinion regarding the public safety of that portion of land. Councilman Zach Farrar made the motion and seconded by Councilman E.T. Stamey. Motion carried.

Mayor Burton request approval of Lincoln Barton's appointment to the Community Action Committee, term ending December 31, 2019. Councilman Larry Gann made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman E.T. Stamey. Motion carried. He also made the request to appoint Allen Tadlock to replace Rick Meredith on the Anderson County Economic Development Board, with a term ending November 30, 2025. Councilman Rob Herrell made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman E.T. Stamey. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

City School Board Report

Ms. Johnson presented the school report recognizing the special education department's award of exemplary status from the State. She continued her report with a facilities update and additional Blaze activities. Scott Rhea presented the financial report and requested approval of budget amendment no. 1. Councilman Jim McBride made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Brian Hatmaker. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Clinton Board of Zoning Appeals

Councilman Larry Gann stated that the Board met January 14, 2019. There was no new business.

Clinton Regional Planning Commission

Councilman Larry Gann stated that the Board met January 14, 2019. The Board discussed the proposed zoning amendment for the downtown area and voted to send a draft copy to the City Attorney and City Council for review and comments. Councilman Gann asked for any questions/comments from Council. Councilman McBride asked for clarification of changes to the downtown area.

Clinton Utilities Board Report

Councilman Zach Farrar presented the CUB report.

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

City Manager Houck commented that in accordance with previously approved practices of the Council, he requested authorization to file for various grant funds through the State and Federal Government and other agencies as appropriate, where such funds are available. This includes, but not be limited to, funds for building renovations, water and sewer improvements and rehabilitation, drainage improvements, infrastructure improvements and funding for additional employees and equipment. Councilman Jim McBride made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Brian Hatmaker. Motion carried.

Gail Cook presented the financial report.

City Manager Houck stated that K-9 Mozzy had been taken out of service due to health issues. Mozzy is a 10 year old German Shepherd with 8 years of service to the Police Department. In keeping with past practices, he recommended that Mozzy be retired and declared surplus and given to his former handler Steven Queener for future care. Councilman E.T. Stamey made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Jim McBride. Motion carried.



Re: **Budget Amendment Number 1** (2018-2019 School Year)

GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND:

The recommended Budget Amendment in General Purpose School Fund increases appropriations by 199,263 (net); which are funded by an increase in revenues.

The information below summarizes significant line item changes:

- Increase in appropriations for "Blaze" Well Rounded Activities \$55,000
 - Funded by Donations, Other Revenues & Fees
- Increase in appropriations for Medical Personnel \$57,000
 - Funded by reduction in other salary appropriations
- Increase in appropriations for School Secretaries \$14,000
 - Funded by reduction in other salary appropriations
- Increase in appropriations for Building Improvements and Cameras \$88,000
 - Funded by Safe Schools Grant and State and Local Revenues

FEDERAL PROJECTS FUND:

The recommended Budget Amendment in Federal Projects Funds increases appropriations by \$3,654.05 (net); which is funded by an increase in grant allocations (net). The Federal Project's budgets are aligned with grant requirements at this time.

CAFETERIA FUND:

No recommended Budget Amendment in Cafeteria Fund at this time.
