

REGULAR CITY COUNCIL - MINUTES

Mayor Scott Burton called the regular City Council meeting to order on April 22, 2019 at Clinton City Hall at 5:34pm. Councilman Larry Gann, Councilman Brian Hatmaker, Councilman Rob Herrell, and Councilman E.T. Stamey were present. Councilman Jim McBride and Councilman Zach Farrar were absent.

Councilman Larry Gann made a motion to approve the agenda and seconded by Councilman E.T. Stamey. Motion carried.

Prayer was led by Councilman Larry Gann followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman E.T. Stamey made a motion to approve March 25, 2019 minutes and seconded by Councilman Brian Hatmaker. Motion carried.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS AND CITIZENS

Mayor Burton asked for comments from the citizens.

Jerry Shattuck 322 Edgewood Cr., discussed how the Mayor's Commission 21st Century, along with City Council, was instrumental in several City projects, including the Riverwalk, up until 2008 when some projects had to be placed on hold. One of the projects was converting the old railroad bridge into a pedestrian bridge extending the Riverwalk, crossing the river to connect to the City's 16 acres. Mr. Shattuck asked council to look into revitalizing the pedestrian bridge project while the state is constructing the new bridge on 25W, stating that the City may be able to benefit from some of the construction equipment and or funds that are already budgeted.

Jennifer Burnette, ASAP, provided an update on future ASAP events.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

City School Board Report

Ms. Johnson presented the school report. She invited council to attend 6th grade graduation on May 23rd at 9:00am. Ms. Johnson stated that the school systems Safe Schools Grant was combined with the state's one time safety funds along with funds from the schools general fund to purchase and install HD surveillance,

security camera systems in all three schools. These cameras allow the police department and SRO's access to monitor the city school system for better security.

Scott Rhea discussed the financial report and asked for approval of budget amendment no. 2. Councilman Brain Hatmaker made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Rob Herrell. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Clinton Board of Zoning Appeals

Councilman Larry Gann stated that the Board met April 8, 2019. Applicant Clinch River CrossFit request for rear signage of 99.16 sq. ft. for property located at 378 Market St. was approved.

Applicant Teresa Clark's request for 34 ft. driveway width for property located at 128 Mountain Meadow Lane was approved.

Request from Applicant Shawn Smith for right side setback to 6 inches and maximum square footage to allow an accessory structure to 1,344 sq. ft. for property located at 127 David Rd. was approved.

Applicant JMB Investment Co. request for parking variance from 27 spaces to 23 spaces for the proposed Advance Auto location on S. Charles Seivers Blvd. was approved.

Applicant JMB Investment Co. request for parking variance from 36 spaces to 31 spaces for the proposed Dollar General location on S. Charles Seivers Blvd. was approved

Clinton Regional Planning Commission

Councilman Larry Gann stated that the Board met April 8, 2019. Applicant Alex McGrew/Duan Brewer's rezoning request from B-1/H-1 to B-1 for properties located at 351,353 and 355 N Cullom Street was deferred.

Applicant Will Robinson & Associates request for site plan review for proposed Fairfield Inn located at 2317 N. Charles G. Seivers Blvd. was approved.

JMB Investment Co. LLC request for final plat review for property located at S. Charles G. Seivers Blvd. Mr. Gann stated this was for the proposed Dollar General, Advance Auto and Fast Pace Stores and was approved contingent on all corrections and appropriate signatures.

Clinton Utilities Board Report

No report, Councilman Farrar absent.

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

Mayor Burton stated that due to the Memorial Day Holiday, City Council meeting would need to be rescheduled. Councilman E.T. Stamey made the motion to reschedule the May meeting to Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at 5:30 seconded by Councilman Brian Hatmaker. Motion carried.

Gail Cook presented the financial report.

Mayor Burton reported that the Public Works Department needed to purchase a Compact Excavator for use in locations where a regular sized excavator or backhoe is impractical. This equipment was available for purchase on a State Contract price schedule and City staff requested authorization to purchase a Bobcat E42 T4 Compact Excavator, from Bobcat of Knoxville for a total cost of \$54,393.30 to be funded from the Public Works Department's Capital Outlay Funds. Councilman E.T. Stamey made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Rob Herrell. Motion carried.

Mayor Burton continued stating that the Public Works Department also needed a Single Axle Dump Truck to replace an older model currently in use. This dump truck was available for purchase on a State Contract price schedule and Staff requested authorization to purchase a 2019 Kenworth Dump Truck from Worldwide Equipment, Inc. of Knoxville for a total cost of \$95,231.00 and would be funded from the Public Works Department's Capital Outlay Funds. Councilman E.T. Stamey made the motion to approve and seconded by Councilman Rob Herrell. Motion carried.

NEW RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES


First Reading of Ordinances
