

ORDINANCE NO. 618

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8 OF
THE CITY OF CLINTON CODE BOOK RELATIVE
TO RETAIL FOOD STORE WINE LICENSES**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton has authority pursuant to *T.C.A. §57-3-501(a)(1)* to impose an inspection fee upon retail food store wine licensees as defined by *T.C.A. § 57-3-101* located within the city; and

WHEREAS, the city council has determined it is in the City's best interest to impose such an inspection fee upon retail food store wine licensees located within the city; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CLINTON, TENNESSEE:**

SECTION 1. Title 8, of the municipal code is amended by adding the following as Chapter 3 – Wine in Retail Food Stores:

Section 8-301. Inspection fee on retail food store wine licensees. Pursuant to the authority contained in Tennessee Code Annotated, § 57-3-501 et.al., there is hereby imposed an inspection fee on retail food store wine licensees. The inspection fee shall be five percent (5%) of the wholesale price of alcoholic beverages as defined in Tennessee Code Annotated, § 57-3-101(a)(1)(A) supplied by a wholesaler to a retail food store wine licensee.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective August 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
