

ORDINANCE NO. 641

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 9 OF
THE CITY OF CLINTON CODE BOOK RELATIVE
TO MOBILE FOOD TRUCK OPERATIONS**

WHEREAS, the city council has determined it is in the City's best interest to regulate the operations of mobile food preparation vehicles within the city; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CLINTON, TENNESSEE:**

SECTION 1. Title 9, of the municipal code is amended as follows:

Section 9-604.

(4) An application for a Mobile Food Unit Permit shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100). An application for a Temporary Mobile Food Unit Permit shall be accompanied by a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) per day not to exceed forty-five dollars (\$45), based on maximum permit period of three (3) days. There will be no charge for a Mobile Food Unit Permit or a Temporary Mobile Food Unit Permit for a mobile food preparation vehicle that is set up at a retail business in conjunction with a special event/sale of that retail business provided that the retail business has a current City of Clinton business license.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
