**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Clinton, Tennessee has caused it's ordinances of a general, continuing, and permanent application or of a penal nature to be codified and revised and the same embodied in a code of ordinances known as the "Clinton Municipal Code",

**WHEREAS**, ordinances of the City of Clinton may be revised as deemed necessary for the public health and welfare of residents,

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton Municipal Planning Commission reviewed the proposed revision on *November 14, 2019* and recommended revising the Municipal Code accordingly; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Clinton, Tennessee that the following section of the Municipal Code of the City of Clinton, Tennessee:

**Section 1.**     **Section 10-102** is hereby revised as follows:

**10-102.** Keeping near a residence or business restricted. Swine are prohibited within the corporate limits. No person shall keep or allow any other animal or fowl enumerated in the preceding section, except as allowed under the provisions of Title 14 of the Clinton Municipal Code.

**Section 2.**     This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
