

RESOLUTION NUMBER 731

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MODIFIED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ANDERSON COUNTY, CLINTON, OAK RIDGE, OLIVER SPRINGS, ROCKY TOP AND THE STATE OF TENNESSEE THAT FORMS THE SEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT CRIME TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the Seventh Judicial District Crime Task Force was formed on April 8, 2011 consisting of the cities of Lake City, Oak Ridge, Oliver Springs and Clinton as well as Anderson County and the State of Tennessee for the purpose of receiving grant funding for cooperative policing, working cooperatively with multiple law enforcement agencies, combating narcotics trafficking and other serious crime, responding to complex crime scenes with expert equipment and manpower and conveying county-wide and in some cases state-wide law enforcement powers on officers credentialed by the Crime Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Seventh Judicial District Crime Task Force has been an unqualified success in its operations and accomplishments over the past five years; and

WHEREAS, the Seventh Judicial District Crime Task Force continues to receive grant funding for law enforcement operations that benefit this community; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Office of Criminal Justice Programs which administers the grant funding is requiring the task forces all across the State of Tennessee to modify their interlocal agreements to include several technical changes; and


WHEREAS, this Interlocal Agreement has been previously approved but is not being changed in any material way and carries no cost, it is desirable to adopt the modified Interlocal Agreement so that grant funds may continue to be received and so that the Crime Task Force may continue operations making our community safer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor of the City of Clinton and Clinton City Council that the Interlocal Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein is approved and the City Manager and Police Chief are hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement or other appropriate legal instruments to accomplish participation in the Seventh Judicial District Crime Task Force upon the terms and conditions contained in the Interlocal Agreement and as may be adopted from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Seventh Judicial District Crime Task Force on behalf of this body and this local government.
