

**RESOLUTION NO. 754**

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A HEALTH INSURANCE  
PREMIUM SUBSIDY FOR RETIREES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, Tennessee permits employees who retire pursuant to T.C.A. §8-35-226 to maintain enrollment in the City's health, dental, and vision plan(s) until eligible for Medicare with the retiree paying the associated premium(s) to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the legislative body of the City of Clinton, Tennessee has determined it is in the best interest of the City to provide a premium subsidy to eligible retirees up to a maximum of three hundred dollar (\$300) per month beginning July 1, 2017; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Clinton, Tennessee, meeting this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2017, that:

**Section 1:** Eligible retirees are defined as any individual that retires on or after July 1, 2017 under the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System (TCRS) eligibility for full service retirement or ordinary disability retirement and chooses to maintain enrollment in the City's health insurance plan.

**Section 2:** Eligible retirees will be entitled to a subsidy of ten dollars (\$10) per month for each year of creditable service with TCRS up to a maximum of three hundred dollars (\$300) per month.

**Section 3:** Eligible retirees will be entitled to a subsidy until eligible for Medicare at age sixty-five or in the case of disability two years after Social Security disability insurance entitlement.
