

RESOLUTION NO. 767

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF A
LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION FUND (LPRF) GRANT APPLICATION
FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT SOUTH CLINTON PARK**


- WHEREAS,** the well-being of the citizens of the City of Clinton is of the greatest importance; and;
- WHEREAS,** all efforts shall be made to provide a safe, healthy play area for the citizens of the City of Clinton and surrounding areas; and
- WHEREAS,** improvements to South Clinton Park are needed in order to enhance the lives of citizens through exceptional parks and recreation facilities; and
- WHEREAS,** the State of Tennessee offers grants to local communities to finance recreational improvements through its LPRF program; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Clinton must submit a formal application in order to be eligible for funding through the LPRF program, said application to request funding for City Park improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clinton, the following:

- Section 1: That the City of Clinton is hereby authorized to submit application for a 2018 LPRF grant not to exceed \$230,000.
- Section 2: That the City of Clinton is hereby authorized to provide a matching sum to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant, up to \$115,000 to be provided by an appropriation in the general fund budget.
- Section 3: That the City of Clinton owns the proposed location and acknowledges the Notice of Limitation of Use to be placed upon the land so that it will only be used for public recreation and the NLU will be registered against the deed of project parcel if the project is selected for funding.
- Section 4: That the City of Clinton acknowledges the project must be completed within two years if the contract is awarded.
- Section 5: That the Mayor of the City of Clinton is aware and assures the project, if selected for funding, will meet all Federal, State and local regulations and requirements including ADA and CPSC and ASTM (for playgrounds).


