

RESOLUTION NO. 796

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A
2020 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION PUBLIC WORKS AND
ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM APPLICATION
TO FUND A WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration (EDA) Program offers grants to local jurisdictions to fund public infrastructure facilities, and

WHEREAS, Counties, municipalities and other entities within the State of Tennessee may apply for such EDA funding; and


WHEREAS, City of Clinton will apply for the EDA grant to fund water system improvements for Clinton Utilities Board; and

WHEREAS, the match for the 2020 Economic Development Administration Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Program for City of Clinton is 20% of total cost or \$677,900, based on a total project cost of \$3,389,500; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton City Council hereby authorizes the City Mayor or his representatives to prepare and submit a 2020 EDA Grant application for funding up to \$2,711,600 to be used for water system improvements for the I-75 Industrial Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clinton Utilities Board agrees to provide matching funds in the amount of 20%, or \$677,900 out of their water funds, based on the total project cost of \$3,389,500 to City of Clinton.
